- Would benefit from hands-on treatment
- Post/Pre-op care
- Ongoing Injury Management/Rehabilitation
- Are not shielding from COVID-19

At Bristol Physio we would like to highlight the steps we are taking to protect both you and our staff

## **Waiting Room**


- Signs on the doors remind the patients of the signs and symptoms of COVID-19
- There is a sign in reception indicating the patient should wash their hands on arrival
- Sign should read that no more than 2 patients should be in reception at one time
- Patients can wait in their car to be called to the appointment (Clifton)
- They should get their temperature taken with the laser thermometer before entering the clinic room
- Patients have to have read the COVID Declaration information sheet (next to front door)
  - o Do you have a current fever  $(37.8^{\circ}\text{C or over})$ ?
  - o Excessive tiredness?
  - o Have you got a new persistent cough?
  - o Do you have slight difficulties breathing at the moment?
  - o Do you feel under the weather in any way at the moment?
  - Has your taste or smell changed?
- If any of these answers are positive and/or the temperature is raised then the individual should be told to head home and isolate following NHS/PHE guidelines.


## PPE


- All clinicians to wear PPE mask, visor (if patient is coughing/sneezing due to asthma/allergies etc or aerosol generating treatment), apron
- Gloves to be used when treating
- Consider use of skin wipes and/or gloves if patient is sweating in the treatment area
- Work clothes to stay at the clinic

#### Clinic room

• At HQ please stay in stay your allocated room and remain in there throughout the appointment – don't go to the gym. It will be easier to clean that room and we have removed all clutter (no couch cover or pillow case).









### **End of consultation**

- Please ask the patient to wash their hands on leaving the room.
- Payment will have to be taken as normal but the card machine needs to be wiped down afterwards (encourage card transactions only).
- Contactless x 2 transactions (£45 max each one)
- Please wipe down all surfaces that the patient will have touched; door handles, card machine, seats, bed, pillow, desk amongst others.
- Towels 1 per patient and wash after each use
- Place all plastic PPE gear into separate bin as these can't be recycled.

If a suspected symptom arises during the consultation please follow these guidelines for managing the issue.

 Please immediately send the patient home and tell to self isolate following NHS guidelines without payment – please send them an invoice to pay over the phone or BACS (at your discretion).

# Deep cleaning policy

- Please wear gloves, apron and masks (if available)
- Open the window
- Clean all hard surfaces
- Clean all doors the patient may have used
- All paper towels and other disposable items have to be double bagged and disposed of immediately.
- Clean the floor
- Wash your hands
- Work Clothes double bagged and taken home to wash at 60°C
- Use the anti-viral aerosols as needed

## **Home Visits**

- Only if completely necessary and if both parties are happy to do so
- A thorough screening on the phone should be conducted and DOCUMENTED on PPS with clinical justification for conducting the HV.
- Take PPE with you, thermometer and hand sanitiser and bin bag to dispose of PPE
- Please ask screening questions before entering the building
- Wash hands on entry and exit
- Once inside please use appropriate common sense when conducting your consultation.
- On leaving the building, please use hand sanitiser before entering your car
